LEONARDO DA VINCI (1452-1519) was an incredible man. He worked as an architect, artist, mathematician and scientist. He also worked as a military engineer and was a good musician. When he was a child, Leonardo liked school but he hated Latin. In 1466, Leonardo's family moved to Florence and he finished school. In 1482, he moved to Milan and started to work for the Duke of Milan. He designed many buildings for the Duke. He also studied mathematics. His drawing of the *Anatomy of a Man* showed him to be a great biologist. In 1502, he returned to Florence and painted the *Mona Lisa*. From 1514 to 1516, he lived in Rome and continued his scientific experiments. Leonardo was a genius, he also invented scissors and drew plans. He made models of tanks, helicopters and a submarine. He died in France in 1519.
